

MLA WORKS CITED: EBOOKS AND AUDIOBOOKS

How to reference an electronic book or an audio recording of a book

AN EBOOK FROM AN ONLINE DATABASE:

- Provide the name of the digital library or database in which you found the ebook. Include the DOI, URL, or permalink.

AN EBOOK FROM A DIGITAL LIBRARY OR BOOKSTORE:

- Cite ebooks purchased from online stores just like print books.
- If the ebook is from a digital library's website, include the library's name and the book's URL.

AN ESSAY, SHORT STORY, OR CHAPTER IN AN EBOOK:

- Omit the page range, unless the ebook has standard pages.
- Shorten lengthy URLs to the host site.

AN AUDIOBOOK:

- Reference like a print book. However, mention the narrator if they are the focus of your discussion.

Atwood, Margaret. *The Handmaid's Tale*. Narrated by Claire Danes, audiobook ed., special ed., Audible, 2017.

IN-TEXT CITATIONS FOR AN EBOOK OR AUDIOBOOK:

- Reference ebooks with nonstandard page numbers by chapter. If the ebook has numbered paragraphs, you may use paragraphs.
- In-text citations of audiobooks may refer to the time (hour:minute:second) of the passage.

Chapter(s): (Usher ch. 2) (Llewellyn et al. chs. 3–5)

Paragraph(s): (Usher para. 5) (Llewellyn et al. ch. 3, paras. 6–12)

Time: (Murad 1:49:21) (Murad 1:49:21–1:52:32)
