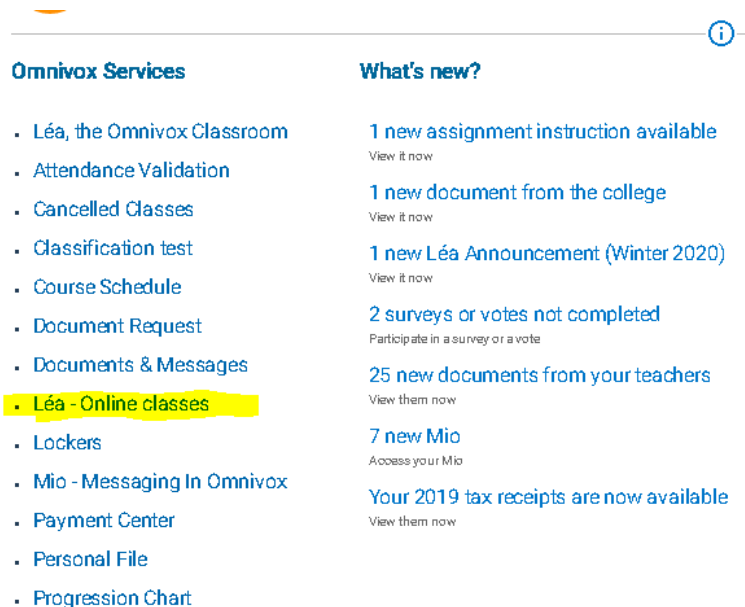


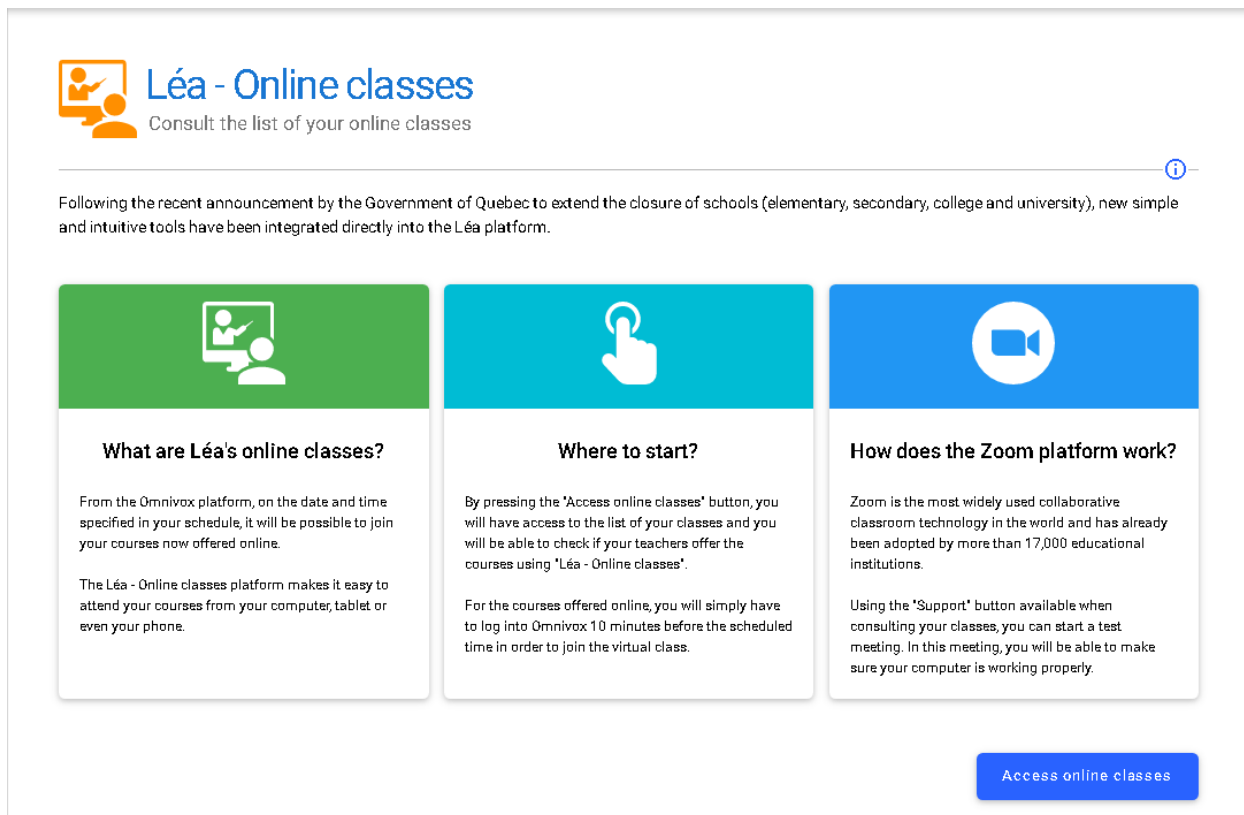
Lea – Online Classes – Student View

From the Omnivox platform, on the date and time specified in your schedule, it will be possible to join your courses now offered online.

The Léa - Online classes platform makes it easy to attend your courses from your computer, tablet or even your phone.
- Where to start?**

By pressing the 'Access online classes' button, you will have access to the list of your classes and you will be able to check if your teachers offer the courses using 'Léa - Online classes'.

For the courses offered online, you will simply have to log into Omnivox 10 minutes before the scheduled time in order to join the virtual class.
- How does the Zoom platform work?**

Zoom is the most widely used collaborative classroom technology in the world and has already been adopted by more than 17,000 educational institutions.

Using the 'Support' button available when consulting your classes, you can start a test meeting. In this meeting, you will be able to make sure your computer is working properly.

How do I know if my course is offered online? 

You can see the list of courses offered online by accessing Léa - Online classes. The list of your classes will be displayed there with a mention indicating whether the course is offered online or not.

How do I join my online course?

A few minutes before the start of the meeting, a link will be available on your Omnivox Home page. Just press the link to join the meeting.

Do I need to install a software or an application to use the online class platform? 

The Zoom platform allows you to install a client on the computer or to start directly in the browser. To use the Zoom platform on a mobile device or tablet, you will need to download the application.

Is it possible to test the Zoom platform to make sure that everything will work correctly during my first meeting? 

It is possible to test Zoom, your internet connection and your hardware, whatever the device you use, by pressing on the following link <https://zoom.us/test>.

Your course will only be available a few minutes before your class starts. Reconnect to Omnivox in a few minutes to gain access to your class.

How can I speak to my teacher?

Your teacher will allow students to use the microphone or not. If your teacher asks you not to use your microphone, a discussion space is available by clicking on "Chat" at the bottom of the screen. You can communicate with him without activating your microphone.
