

Statement of student consent agreeing to be recorded during online course sessions

1. Video recording of class sessions

This online class may be recorded by the teacher. This means that the audio-visual and chat portions of the class will be recorded and then be stored on the College server. They will be made available through Microsoft Stream, but only for the express and sole use of those registered in this course. The recorded material will be removed from Microsoft Stream at the end of the semester.

If you do not want to be recorded, please turn off your audio or video, or both. If you turn off your audio, you may still be required to participate by means established by the teacher.

No other recording of the sessions is permitted. The sharing, altering, or distorting of any audio-visual capture of a class session is not permitted. As a student participating in an online learning environment, you must abide by all College rules and regulations including, but not limited to, rules in your course outline, the [Code of Conduct Policy](#), the [Policy on Sexual Violence](#), the [Policy to Stem Violence, Discrimination, Harassment and the Abuse of Power](#), and the [Dawson User IT Policy](#), as well as any applicable laws. Any violation of these rules may lead to sanctions, up to and including expulsion from the College, or legal action.

2. Video recording during assessment activities

The teacher may use video recording during sessions where the students are being evaluated, such as during tests and exams, oral presentations or physical demonstrations. In those cases, the recording is for the express purposes of conducting assessment and ensuring academic integrity. These videos will be stored on the teacher's computer and can only be accessed by the teacher, or members of the Grade Review committee, if a grade is appealed by the student. After the appeal deadline is passed, any such video will be permanently deleted. A student who does not want to be recorded may discuss alternate evaluation schemes with the teacher, who will attempt to accommodate the request.
