

What Do My French Placement Results Mean?

The French Placement Test helps us to place you in the appropriate level of French. **Even if you are a Quebec high school student, this information regarding French Placement results is applicable to you.** Students need two credit-level French courses (a Block A and a Block B course) in order to receive their DEC.

To access your results simply log back into your [My Dawson](#) account and go to Placement Test Results (found under the Placement Test tab).

What Do the Results Mean?

Most students will be placed in one of the following (45-hour) courses:

- 602-100-MQ Basic French (Français de base)
- 602-101-MQ French Language & Communication (Langue française et communication)
- 602-102-MQ French Language & Culture (Langue française et culture)
- 602-103-MQ French Culture & Literature (Langue française et littérature)

Please note: Your skill level in French will be reassessed in class during the first week of classes. Your French teacher is the ONLY person with the authority to transfer you to a higher or lower-level French course.

Some students will be placed at a lower level and will need to take additional preparatory French courses *before* registering in the two (2) **required** college-level French courses.

If you **have not** completed Secondary V French in Quebec and you are placed in:

602-FRA-DW (90 hours)
Pratique du français langue
seconde 1 et 2

You may take this credit course through Continuing Education. You should register for the appropriate course as soon as possible, through the Help Line on *your scheduled registration date*. **Failure to do so may delay your graduation from Dawson.** This course will also be offered in the summer as an intensive course at a cost of approximately \$230* (602-FRA-DW).

602-04B-DW (45 hours)
Pratique du français langue
seconde 4 or
602-FRB-DW (90 hours)
Pratique du français langue
seconde 3 et 4

You may take these credit courses through Continuing Education. You should register for the appropriate course as soon as possible, through the Help Line on *your scheduled registration date*. **Failure to do so may delay your graduation from Dawson.** These courses prepare students for the 602-008-DW Mise à niveau pour français, langue seconde de la 5e secondaire course.
602-04B-DW (will also be offered in the summer as an intensive course at a cost of approximately \$140.*
602-FRB-DW will also be offered in the summer as an intensive course at a cost of approximately \$230.*

602-008-RE (60 hours)
Mise à niveau pour
français, langue seconde
de la 5e secondaire

You may register for this Day course at no extra cost. This course will also be offered in the summer as an intensive course at a cost of approximately \$170.*

If you **have** completed Secondary V French in Quebec and are placed in:

602-009-DW (60 hours)
Mise à niveau pour
français, accent sur l'écrit

You may take this as a Day course. This course will also be offered in the summer as an intensive course at a cost of approximately \$170.*

*There are additional fees for students residing outside Quebec.
