- Your student number and program
- Maiden name (if applicable)
- Permanent home address (with postal code)
- Local telephone number
- All fees as published in the relevant timetable
- Provide the proxy with the list of courses in which to be registered be sure to include alternatives in case your first choice of courses is filled.

- Do you know the attendance policy of the teacher/department?

  reading assignments from the teachers for you.
