Reading questions

Examples

- Most people think psychology is only about therapy and mental illness, or even mind-reading and dream-analysis. What did YOU think about psychology before you started reading? After you've read p.13-25 of your textbook, how would you describe the field of psychology? How has your view changed? (1 participation pt; length ¼-1/2 page) Submit before class starts.
- This is a long article: I don't want you to read all of it. Simply follow these instructions.
 1- Read the abstract of the paper by Oreopoulous and Dechief (2011): Matthew or Samir ... (p. 5 & 6). Answer this question: describe a real-life situation where you think you witnessed discrimination described by the authors. If you can't think of any, describe another situation where you've witnessed some form of ethnic discrimination (overt or covert).

2- Skim the paper by **only** looking at the titles and subtitles and formulate at least 10 questions based on these titles and subtitles. In other words. I **don't** want you to read the paper, just the titles and subtitles and formulate 10 Questions.
